No meal distribution on December 30th due to Winter Break

The Upper Darby School District will continue to offer free meals for the week at the locations listed below. Meals are for all school age children, as well as children under the age of 6, and any child who lives in Upper Darby Township and attends other schools, including private, charter and cyber schools.

All food is prepared by Aramark Food Services--the District's contracted food service provider. Any child, parent or guardian who resides in Upper Darby township may pick up 14 weekly meals total (7 breakfasts and 7 lunches) on Mondays and Wednesdays between 11:30 am and 1:30 pm. Crossing guards, cafeteria staff, and school security will be on location for assistance. Meals may be picked up at any location listed below. If you are unsure as to your closest location, please refer to the visual examples in this document.

Some families have asked for early morning pick up times for working families. We will make every effort to accommodate those requests, and we will do so by appointment. Please email <u>UDFood@upperdarbysd.org</u> to schedule a morning pick up time at the high school.

Everyone must wear a mask when picking up meals, and practice social distancing while in line.

Middle School and High School Food Locations

- Beverly Hills Middle School and Upper Darby High School students should pick up breakfast and lunch at the closest elementary school to their home: Bywood Elementary School, Highland Park Elementary School, Stonehurst Hills Elementary School.
- Drexel Hill Middle School and Upper Darby High School students should pick up breakfast and lunch at the closest elementary school to their home: Aronimink Elementary School, Garrettford Elementary School, Hillcrest Elementary School, Primos Elementary School, Westbrook Park Elementary School.

We have provided visual examples below for each of the identified food locations. The school listed in the large circle is the elementary food grab and go pick-up location. The schools listed to the right of elementary school food locations are schools whose neighborhoods may be closest to the identified elementary schools listed in the larger circle.


