



- Ticket sales will begin April 28, 2025. Cash Only.
- Ticket sales will end May 23, 2025. **No exceptions.**
- At the time of purchase you will be asked to select the table at which you will be seated and if you will be attending After Prom. Tables at Drexelbook seat 12.
- **ALL** obligations must be satisfied before students will be permitted to purchase a ticket to the Senior Prom (view *Obligations & Conduct*).
- Students must fill out the required form used for all dances at UDHS, requiring name, phone, date's name & phone, and list of rules for our dances. Parent signatures are required (even if you are 18 years or older).
- All guests must have ID to attend the prom. Guests may not be 21 years or older.
- Drexelbrook and Upper Darby High School will have security guards on the premises who are there to enforce the conference center and school rules. **Students must arrive before 8:30 p.m. at Drexelbook** or they will not be permitted to attend the prom.
- Any senior student wishing to attend the After Prom can pick up a ticket in the Senior Center, even if you are not attending Prom.
- After Prom is from 11:00 p.m. to 3:00 a.m. Students must enter before 1:15 a.m. Be advised that once a student has entered the After Prom Party, they may not leave until 3:00 a.m. **No exceptions.**
- Alcoholic beverages, electric cigarettes, vapes, illicit drugs, and marijuana are **strictly prohibited** from the Prom and After Prom. Violations will result in removal from Prom and precludes the student from participating in graduation.

\*Participation in Senior Activities is a privilege. Students with fewer than 85 Royal Points are not allowed to take part in activities like Senior Appreciation Day and Prom. Privileges can be revoked until the day of events. The Principal will review all Tier 3 violations for potential loss of senior privileges, including prom and graduation ceremony.

## A Celebrated Tradition

Commencement is a formal, academic ritual that merits the highest dignity and respect. Each senior will receive **5** general admission tickets. Students may request up to 5 additional tickets by Thursday, May 22, 2025, via Google Form that will be shared. Seating will be on a first come, first served basis. Additional tickets are on a first come, first serve. Students will receive tickets in graduation rooms on June 6, 2025, after rehearsal. Students are required to attend commencement rehearsal. Failure to attend rehearsal will result in student unable to walk in commencement ceremony. **Signatures from all students will be required at that time.** 

We encourage students, families, and friends to present themselves in a manner befitting the occasion. We ask you kindly to save flowers, balloons, and other gifts until Seniors leave the Liacouras Center.

Students are expected to arrive at the high school properly dressed, with no alterations or additions to the prescribed cap and gown outfit. Graduates will receive their cap and gown at Commencement Rehearsal on Friday, June 6, 2025. Students with outstanding obligations will not be permitted to participate in the Graduation Ceremony and will not receive their cap and gown on this date.

- Students must be at school by 7:30 a.m.
- Ceremony begins *promptly* at 11:00 a.m.
- Five tickets per student
- Ceremony will be streamed to watch from home
- Busses will take students to Liacouras by Graduation Room
- No family transportation provided
- Return transportation will be provided to students upon request

## **Obligations & Conduct**

**Every parent/guardian should be able to hear their child's name announced.** We thank you for your cooperation in this regard. Students may not carry anything with them in the procession. This includes: purses, water bottle, etc. No balloons or other visual obstructions may be brought into the seats at the Liacouras Center.

Students must fulfill **ALL** obligations or they will not be permitted to participate in the graduation ceremony. **Obligations are due Thursday, June 5, 2024 at 12:00 p.m.**
