

What is a Lock-Out?

- Bring students that are outside into the school.
- Conduct normal school operations.
- All ingress and egress will be by the main entrance, under the supervision of police, security, or administrator.
- Updates will be provided.
- Dismissal time may be delayed.
- Prepare for possible Lockdown or Evacuation



What is a Lock-In?

- Close classroom door.
- Conduct normal classroom activity.
- No one leaves classroom.
- Hallways and common areas clear of all students.
- Updates will be provided.
- Class change or dismissal time may be delayed.



What is a Lockdown?

• Implement District response procedures as a result of a life threatening event occurring inside the school, on school grounds, or immediately adjacent to the school, that has a high probability of moving onto school grounds.



Active Shooter

- **RUN**: Run away from shooter. Direct Contact-or-Can't Secure Area-or-Clear Escape Path.
- **HIDE**: Lock yourself in a secured area and remain out of the shooter's sight. Indirect Contact-or-Can Secure Room-or- No Clear Path of Escape.
- **FIGHT**: Resist or fight back. Direct Contact.



Evacuation

- Fire Drill or HazMat Situation
- Know Your Exit Route
- Rally Point On and Off Site
- Take Attendance
- Utilize CrisisGo for checklist and communication
